

FIRE AND EMERGENCY SAFETY PLAN

A VOLUNTEER NEEDED

The Centre needs **ONE** person from **EACH PARISH** to be responsible for ensuring all the Fire Safety Plans are made known. At the moment, should an emergency occur, all we have are the EXIT signs. We need to know that all routes are known from all locations by as many people as possible.

For example: all Sunday School teachers should know how to and where to get the children out of **ALL** locations, not just the basement. If there is a need to exit the building during a service, who is *responsible* for ensuring 911 is called? If there are people of limited mobility, who is designated to ensure they can leave, quickly? If you are having a knitting group in the Lounge, do you know the exits and alternate routes? Bingo: can people be directed to leave in an orderly manner even if they are not familiar with the building's many exits?

As a volunteer you will get the names of the leaders of all groups and ensure they have a copy of the Fire Safety Plans, **read and understand them and pass this knowledge along to others**. All designated persons from any group will attend one of two meetings with a Fire/Police spokesperson, and this will be a social evening, as well. The Volunteer will make sure that others have the tools to do their jobs.
